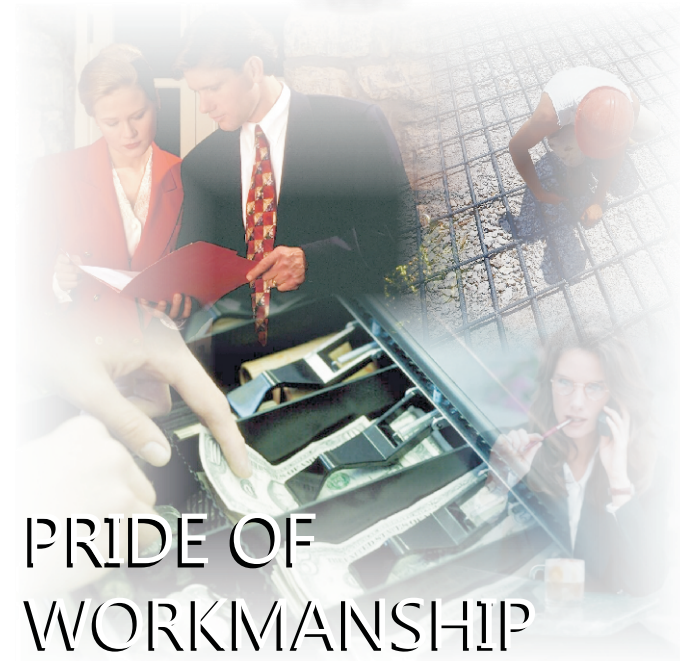

The Rotary Club of Hamilton was sponsored by the Rotary Club of Fortitude Valley. After an inaugural meeting held at "Coolden", New Farm, in July, 1956, the Club had its first official meeting at Royal Queensland Golf Club where it has continued to meet ever since.

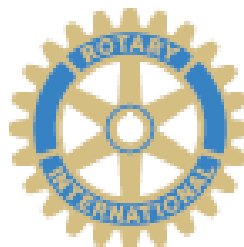
The club's charter was granted by Rotary International on 23rd November 1956 and presented to the club on 23rd February 1957 at a function held at Lennon's Hotel, Brisbane.

Always considered to be among the "top" clubs of the District, The Rotary Club of Hamilton has been involved in numerous service projects within the community, nationally and internationally. The Club has provided two District Governors, Glen Kinross in 1973/74 and Alan Millard in 1983/84.

It is intended that the awards will be presented at a the meeting and dinner to be held on the **15th November 2011 at 6.15pm at the Royal Queensland Golf Club**, Curtain Avenue, Eagle Farm. The Pride of Workmanship awardees will be invited to the meeting and dinner that they will attend free of charge.
